1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

An apology for absence was submitted on behalf of David Horsler.

2. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

There were no declarations of interest.

3. MINUTES

The minutes of the briefing held on 28th October, 2014 were approved as a correct record, subject them being dated correctly.

4. RELOCATION OF SALFORD WAR MEMORIAL

The Strategic Director for Environment and Community Safety submitted a report seeking guidance as to the most appropriate method to determine a permanent location for the Salford Corporation War Memorial, which would allow it to be accessed by the general public. It was indicated that the memorial, which honoured employees of the Salford Corporation and police officers who had died in World War One, had originally been displayed in the former Salford Town Hall, Bexley Square. Following the sale of that building for conversion to private housing, it had been held in storage, prior to it currently forming part of a temporary exhibition at Salford Museum and Art Gallery.

RESOLVED: THAT the matter be referred to the East Salford Community Committee, who be asked to determine the most suitable public building to become the new permanent location of the Salford Corporation War Memorial.
