## Notes for Elected Members and Members of the Public

### **(a) Addressing the Ceremonial Mayor during Council Meetings**

During Council meetings the City Mayor, Elected Members, Officers and members of the public shall address the Ceremonial Mayor as “Chair” when speaking at the Council meeting.

### **(b) Points of Order and Personal Explanations**

a) If a Member or Officer stands on a point of order or to give a personal explanation:

- the Member shall be heard immediately, and
- any Member or Officer speaking shall sit down.

b) A point of order shall relate only to an alleged irregularity in the constitution or conduct of the meeting, and the Member or Officer shall immediately give details of the allegation (if possible, identifying any Standing Order or statute considered to have been broken).

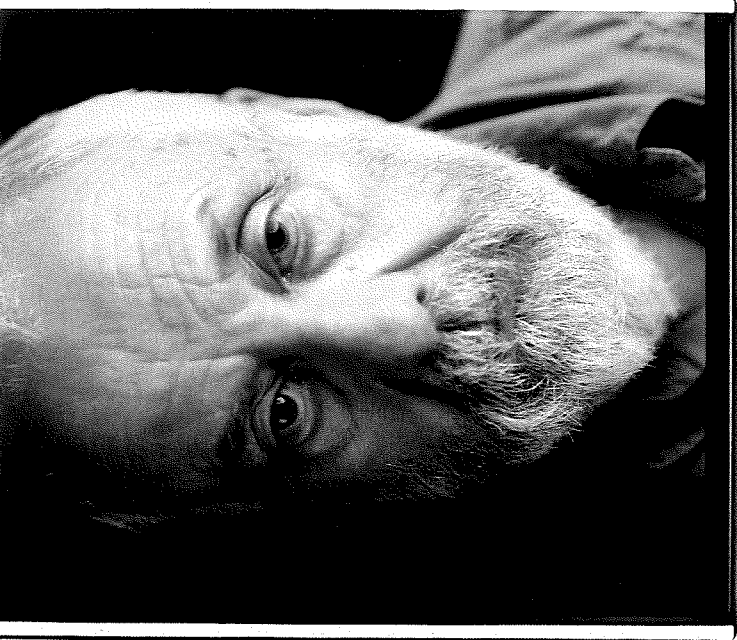
c) A personal explanation shall only be to clear a misunderstanding of something said by the Member or Officer.

d) The ruling of the Chair on a point of order or a personal explanation shall be at his or her discretion.

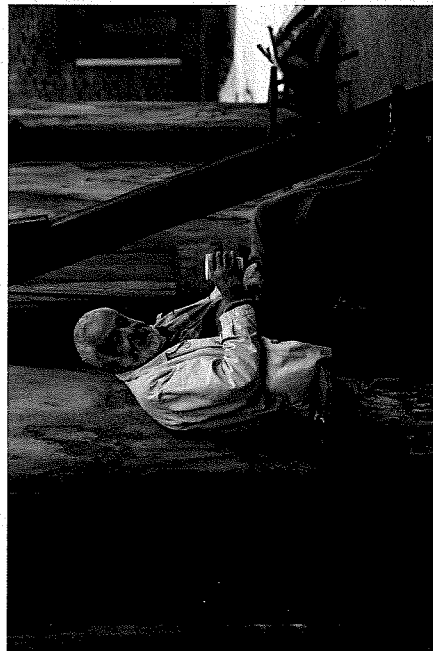

# Order of proceedings

The Ceremonial Mayor will then request that the Council votes on the motion, to grant the Freedom of the City to Mr Mike Leigh.

The Chief Executive, Mr Jim Taylor will ask Mr Leigh to sign the declaration, confirming his acceptance of the Freedom of the City of Salford.

The Ceremonial Mayor, City Mayor and Chief Executive will then sign the declaration.

The Chief Executive will present Mr Leigh with an illuminated scroll and medal, granting the Honorary Freedom of the City of Salford.

Mr Mike Leigh will give his acceptance speech.

The Ceremonial Mayor will formally conclude the ceremony and invite everyone to join them for Afternoon Tea which will be served in the Salford Suite.

The Ceremonial Mayor, Councillor Charlie McIntyre and the Chief Executive, Mr Jim Taylor, will enter the Council Chamber at 2.00pm.

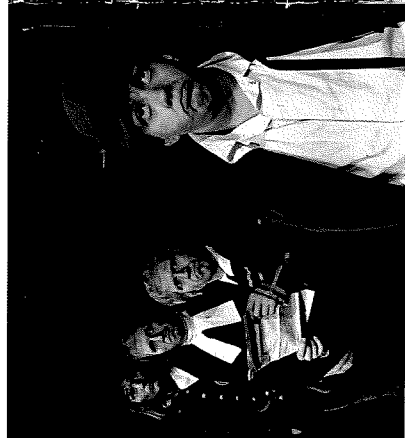
