<p>A4</p>	<p>Block 3 Transport Capital Programme 2021/22</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Salford City Council - Record of Decision</u></p> <p>I, Councillor Tracy Kelly, Deputy City Mayor, in exercise of the powers contained within the Salford City Council constitution do hereby approve the proposed Block 3 Transport Capital Programme for 2021/22</p> <p>The Reasons are The Department for Transport (DfT) is to announce the allocation of funding to Salford City Council for the 2021/22 Block 3 programme of work and although not yet confirmed, is expected be around £1.3m, with a further £205k to be allocated from the completed 2020/21 Broom Lane scheme. The funding will provide for minor infrastructure improvement projects such as, road safety schemes, structure/bridge improvements, schemes to improve walking and cycling facilities and transportation.</p> <p>Assessment of Risk: Medium</p> <p>Failure to spend Transport Capital Allocations on initiatives in line with Government guidelines will impact on future settlement levels, both for the City Council and for AGMA as a whole.</p> <p>Source of funding: The Department for Transport (DfT) Block 3 Funding 2021/22</p> <p>Legal Advice Obtained: Tony Hatton, Principal Solicitor.
