The Committee noted that the hours applied for were modest and in keeping with the type of premises the Applicant described as intending to operate.</p> <p>The Committee took into account the fact that 8 pm is not a noise sensitive time and considered that even if all customers were dispersed together at that time this should not cause a noise nuisance to local residents in the area and that the</p>
