

Admission to Salford Royal

Smoking status and level of addiction assessed
Recorded on EPR Lifestyle Document
NRT prescribed and provided
Referral to Specialist Smoking Service (SRFT SSS)

SRFT SSS meet with patient to provide expert advice and support
Offer Champix and check NRT provision
Ascertain preferences for further smoking cessation support outside of hospital

Discharge

Patients who are confident about their ability to quit or who refuse support

Central government funding
No limit

First or second attempt quitters who chose NRT to support a quit

Pharmacy support and NRT

Advice and support for four weeks
Provide NRT via voucher or by prescription

Currently funded by Public Health
Limited to 1,000 quits across Pharmacy and GP

First or second attempt quitters who chose Champix to support a quit

Pharmacy support and Champix

Advice and support for four weeks,
Provide Champix under PGD

PGD required, Funding would be required
Estimated 900 additional patients per year

Patients who have had multiple quit attempts or a health condition made worse through smoking

Specialist Stop Smoking Service

Advice and support for up to six weeks via:
Email
Text
Phone
Face to Face
Provide NRT vouchers and signpost to pharmacist for Champix if required

SRFT SSS and SCC SSS to provide merged service in the community based in localities.
SCC SSS funded by Public Health
SRFT SSS funded by CCG
