Dear The Delph

Thank you for your time last week where we discussed your premises variation. From this discussion I have drafted the following.

Whilst the variation has been submitted all conditions that are currently on the license shall still apply. With a few Exceptions

On the current license you are permitted to have 20 persons seated in the outside areas to the front of the premises.

From discussion this number shall be increased to 60 persons in the outside area to the front of the premises.

The outside area / beer garden shall be cleared of all patrons by 23:00 hours, save access and egress of patrons from the premises.

Therefore the following amendments are to be applied to the license.

Prevention of public nuisance:

Supervisor to control music volume

Signage displayed to respect residents

Minimise littering

CONDITION 1

All necessary steps shall be taken to ensure that any noise from the premises shall not be at a level which could cause nuisance at the boundary of the nearest residential premises, therefore:-

**No noise from electronically amplified music and speech shall emanate from the premises nor vibration be transmitted through the structure of the premises that give rise to a nuisance.**

Noise from patrons and entertainment within the building shall not impact on the enjoyment and use of the adjoining premises

There shall not be any external speakers to the front of the premises.

Noise from the external speaker in the rear court yard shall be turned

off at 23:30 hours

**CONDITION 2**

All doors, including internal double doors and windows shall be closed at all times when regulated entertainment is occurring. Except for the sole purpose of access and egress of the building.

**CONDITION 3**

There shall be no noise from emptying of bottles and glasses in the outside bins between the hours of 21:00 to 07:00. There shall be no noise from the movement of bins and rubbish between the hours of 23:00 to 08:00 on any day. The premises and the immediate surrounding area shall be kept clean and free from litter at all times.

**CONDITION 4**

**The use of any outdoor space to which you are entitled to use to the front of the premises shall be restricted to a maximum of 60 persons at any times. (Please note this is a reduction in numbers to your application.)**

The designated premises supervisor shall ensure that tables are cleared of all bottles and glass on a regular basis during trading hours to avoid an accumulation of glassware.

**Drinks shall not be allowed in the outside areas after 23:00 hours**

**CONDITION 5**

There shall be a documented and implemented smoking and dispersal policy. With a copy of the policy lodged with the councils licensing department and subsequently kept up to date. There shall be placed at all exits from the premises in a place where they can be seen and easily read by the public, notices requiring customers to leave the premises and the area quietly.

**CONDITION 6**

No deliveries must be made to the premises between 19:30 and 08:00 hours Monday to Saturday. There shall be no deliveries on a Sunday.

The deliveries shall be carried out in such manner as to prevent nuisance and disturbance to nearby residents.

The licensee will ensure that staff who arrive early morning or depart late at night (ex for unpacking, pricing newly delivered goods) when the business has ceased trading conduct themselves in such a manner to avoid causing disturbance to nearby residents.

Any lighting on or outside the Premises will be positioned and screened in such a way so as to not cause a nuisance and disturbance to nearby residents.
