What is the CSP?

The Salford Community Safety Partnership (CSP) is made up of public and private agencies. The key partner agencies include:

- ▶ Salford City Council
- ▶ Greater Manchester Police
- ▶ Greater Manchester Fire and Rescue Service
- ▶ National Probation Service
- ▶ Health (formerly public health and the CCG)
- ▶ Many other public and private organizations actively contribute to the work of the partnership

The overarching aim of the Community Safety Partnership is to reduce crime and anti social behaviour and build safer stronger, more resilient communities in Salford.

Community Safety Partnerships have a statutory requirement to develop a community safety strategy which:

- ▶ Addresses the identified crime and disorder in the area
- ▶ Sets out the priorities that the partnership will deliver to impact on these
- ▶ Identifies the role of each partner agency in supporting delivery of the priorities and how this will be resourced,
- ▶ Contains performance measures and information about the way in which the partnership will engage with their communities

Current Priorities of the CSP for 22-23

Driving	Driving down crime <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Serious organised and violent crime
Tackling	Tackling anti social behaviour <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Crime in neighbourhoods
Building	Building resilient communities <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Community cohesion and hate crime
Protecting	Protecting vulnerable people <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Protecting victims of domestic abuse
Offending	Reducing offending <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Youth crime prevention (e.g.knife crime)

Development of Community Safety Strategy 2024 - 2027

- ▶ Collate available analysis/needs assessment February/March 2023
- ▶ Consult with elected members February and Scrutiny May
- ▶ Strategy in draft June/July
- ▶ Consult with communities July/August
- ▶ Taken through Cabinet process to full Council October/November
- ▶ Sign off November/December
