**TITLE: SECTION 85 LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1972
- REQUEST FOR ABSENCE OF LEAVE**

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That, in accordance with Section 85 of the Local Government Act 1972, Council approves Councillor Karen Garrido's non-attendance at meetings until 31 July 2022 on medical grounds and the Council's best wishes be conveyed to her.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

The purpose of this report is to consider an extension of the 6 month rule for Councillor Karen Garrido on medical grounds.

DETAILS:

Section 85 of the Local Government Act 1972 states that if a member of a local authority fails throughout a period of six consecutive months from the date of their last attendance to attend any meeting of the authority, they shall, cease to a member of the authority. The only exception is if their non-attendance has been approved by the authority before the expiry of that period. Attendance can be at any committee or sub-committee, or at any joint committee, joint board or other body where the functions of the authority are discharged, or who were appointed to advise the

authority on any matter relating to the discharge of their functions. Section 85 of the Act allows an authority to grant dispensation for such absence providing the dispensation is granted before the 6 month period of absence has expired. The next scheduled Council meeting is after the expiration of this period.

Councillor Karen Garrido has been unable to attend meetings recently for medical reasons. The last meeting she attended was the Overview and Scrutiny Board on 3 November 2021. She is currently awaiting treatment following which there will be a period of recovery. Under the circumstances, it is requested that Council approve an extension of the 6 month rule for Councillor Garrido until 31 July 2022. This would not prevent Councillor Garrido from returning to meetings at any time if her health allowed.
