EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

In March 2021, Salford's City Mayor launched 'The Salford Way': a response to the Greater Manchester Independent Inequalities Commission's recommendations and a realisation of the ambitions within 'The Great Eight' priorities.

The Salford Way approach contains three interlinked strategies: Tackling Poverty; Inclusive and Green Economy; and the Equalities and Inclusion Strategy.

Since then, work has been ongoing across the council and wider city partnerships to implement the strategies. This report contains some of the highlights and achievements delivered within the first year and sets out the direction for the next three years of The Salford Way, **attached as appendix 1**.

The intention is that this report would be published (and promoted) externally on the council website.
